Yoram Ettinger is an expert on US-Israel relations and Middle East affairs, a diplomat (Ambassador), researcher, writer, lecturer, commentator and consultant to US and Israeli legislators and their staff. He is the author of weekly English and Hebrew articles, which are posted on www.TheEttingerReport.com. Yoram is the co-founder of the America-Israel Demographic Research Group, which has exposed the myth of the Arab demographic time bomb, while documenting an unprecedented Jewish demographic momentum.

From 1989 to 1992 Yoram was in-charge of Israel's relations with the US Congress – with the rank of Ambassador - at Israel's Embassy in Washington, DC. From 1988 to 1989 he was Director of Israel's Government Press Office, coordinating relations with overseas journalists. From 1985 to 1988 he was Israel's Consul General to the Southwestern USA, based in Houston, Texas, which serviced the states of Texas, Louisiana, Arkansas, Oklahoma and New Mexico. Prior to that he worked as Deputy Director of the US Cultural Center in Jerusalem, Information Officer at Israel's Consulate General in L.A. and Head of a Middle East research unit in Israel's civil service.

Additionally, Yoram has at various times lectured on Mideast Politics and US politics at Hebrew University, been the Alabama Trade Representative in Israel, and editor of the Contemporary Mideast Backgrounder, which was published in Hebrew, English, Spanish, French and German.

His education includes a B.A. in Business Administration, Univ. of Texas at El Paso and a masters degree in International Management at UCLA. Yoram lives in Jerusalem and is married to Ora Ettinger with three daughters and four grandchildren (so far).
